Cap and Gown Ordering

Cap and Gown Ordering will be discussed on November 3rd during Nest. Ordering will take place November 3rd to December 12th. If finances are a concern, please reach out to one of us to ensure your student gets their order placed. If your student has access to a graduation gown from a sibling or former student (it must be black and have the embroidered redbird on it)-they will still need a cap and tassel.

Graduation Practice – May 27 Noon-2pm

Practice will take place on the Nowak Family Field at DPHS. Seniors will walk through the graduation ceremony, find seats, and practice the line-up. Students must have all obligations met (books turned in, fees paid, etc.) in order to attend the graduation ceremony. Casual dress is fine – no cap and gown needed. Graduation tickets will be distributed to seniors **after** practice is completed.

Graduation Ceremony – May 27 at 7:00 pm

Outdoor Ceremony: The graduation ceremony will be held at the Nowak Family Field at De Pere High School. Each student will receive **6** tickets to the ceremony.

Indoor Ceremony: In the event of inclement weather, the graduation ceremony will be moved to the high school gym and each graduate will only be able to have **4** guests due to seating capacity. The remaining 2 tickets will allow access to watch the livestream from the auditorium.

Senior students have been assessed a **Graduation Fee** of approximately \$15 to cover the cost of rental items which will be paid online along with student class fees at the beginning of the year.
