




Wellness Snack

- play with friends when finished




Assessments

Small Group vs. Whole Group


- Small group is working with a teacher on their individualized reading/math level.
- Whole group is grade level instruction where students have the opportunity for collaborative work and independent practice. Students are graded on their performance on independent tasks and participation during whole group instruction.




HOMework

- **Homework should not be a point of frustration for your child.**


