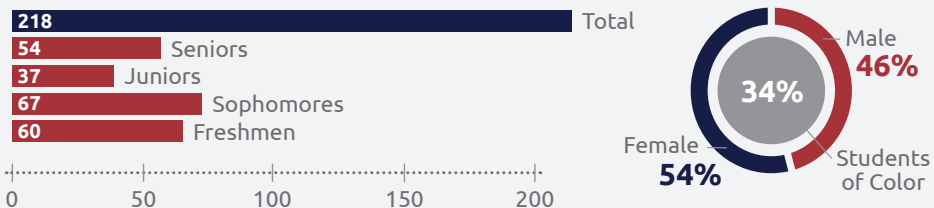
THE SCHOOL

Located on a 60-acre school site in Central Florida, All Saints Academy is a fully accredited, coed, college preparatory day school, providing PreK through grade 12 education and affiliated with the Episcopal Church. Founded in 1966, All Saints Academy values diversity of religious beliefs, races and creeds. Our mission is to inspire independent thinkers, principled leaders and humble learners.

All Saints has a full range of Lyceum Merit Studies (Honors) and AP courses for students who are prepared to accept the most challenging academic workload. In its approach to education, All Saints Academy focuses on maintaining a culture of academic excellence, 21st century learning, preparation for college and beyond, and educating and inspiring the whole child.

Three years ago, All Saints transitioned to a semester schedule on a 5-day rotation. Students take seven classes per semester, with full-year courses lasting two semesters. Each semester lasts for 18 weeks. Each class meets for 55 minutes, four out of the five days in the rotation. Prior to this, the Middle School and Upper School academic year was divided into six terms, each lasting six weeks. During each term, students took four academic blocks that met daily for 80 minutes each, totaling 24 blocks a year. Three blocks of credit in the six-term schedule equaled a full year course.

CLASS RANK AND GPA

All Saints Academy does not report traditional class rank due to the academic nature of the school, the size of each class and the interest in reducing unhealthy competition among students. ASA does provide decile rankings to students if requested by a college, service academy, or scholarship program.

GPA is calculated on a four point scale. Only courses taken at All Saints Academy are included in the GPA calculation.
