There are two Academic Pathways to choose from:

ENGLISH LANGUAGE (A1-B1 Levels): Designed for international students, this pathway develops foundational skills in reading, writing, listening and speaking. Using engaging, content-rich topics, it supports learners from beginner to intermediate levels in building confidence and accuracy in everyday communication.

ADVANCED ENGLISH WITH GLOBAL STUDIES (B2-C2 Levels): Ideal for learners at upper-intermediate level and above, this pathway blends advanced language development with thought-provoking global themes. Through discussion, analysis and collaborative projects, students enhance fluency, critical thinking and academic English. It is equally beneficial for native speakers seeking to refine and expand their language and communication skills.
