VI. Presentations: 2025-2026 Building Goals

Principals and Assistant Principals shared goals in the areas of teaching and learning, climate and culture, communication, social-emotional/well-being and financial stewardship. Dr. Bocian and Mrs. Hayner from WMS highlighted MTSS, the use of student data, student recognitions and student feedback, parent engagement strategies, expenditure practices, and the emphasis on community. Mr. Voynovich and Mrs. McMullen from WHS noted the alignment of goals to The Six Rights: Right People, Right Structure, Right Rewards, Right Resources, Right Decisions and Right Processes. They highlighted strengthening Tier I instruction, implementing Tier I Executive Functioning, creation of a shared vision for grading and feedback, integrated SEL supports, shared budgeting alignment, AI use, and PGP plans & evaluations. The WHS team ended by sharing information on cell phone policy, bell schedules, exam schedules and grading, and attendance updates. Mrs. Earhart and Mrs. Arata from the Primary schools focused on MAP growth, highlighting math and literacy practice profiles along with using MTSS to provide robust support for academic intervention. They also noted SEL curriculum and how teachers are using the morning meeting activity.




