Special Transportation Regulations

Special transportation services are provided only for students who qualify under one of the following:

- McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Act
- Foster Care regulations
- Section 504 accommodations
- Individualized Education Program (IEP) transportation requirements for students with disabilities

Transportation Services

- Transportation is provided from the student's home to their assigned school and back, based on approved routing requests.
 - The home address used for routing is the primary address as listed in the student's Infinite Campus profile
- Transportation is not automatically "door-to-door" unless specifically required as an accommodation due to a student's disability-related limitations and outlined in the student's IEP.
- Once a student is designated for special transportation (because transportation is required for the student to access school or a program), the student may also be transported to an alternate pick-up or drop-off location.

Alternate Pick-Up/Drop-Off Locations

- The alternate location must meet one of the following conditions:
 - A home or residence within Clayton County limits.
 - A licensed daycare facility within Clayton County, where an adult is present to receive the student.
 - Another Clayton County school site for participation in the Campus Kids program.

Important Notes on Alternate Locations

- Alternate locations may be denied if they are excessively far from the student's point of origin and cannot be reasonably accommodated through routing.

Restrictions

- Special transportation does not provide service to businesses, community centers, or private therapy/activities at parent request.
- Special transportation is provided only to the qualifying student with the identified disability or accommodation. Transportation is not available for siblings or other family members.
- To maintain stability and meet routing requirements for all riders, students must ride the same assigned route daily. Alternate drop-off addresses cannot vary by day of the week (e.g., Monday–Wednesday at one address and Tuesday–Thursday at another).
