We believe that financial need should not discourage a student from applying to SYA. In addition to our need-based financial aid, we offer a variety of merit-based scholarship awards to assist families with providing their children the outstanding academic experience that SYA offers.

SYA scholarship opportunities include merit and need-based awards. In order to be considered, applicants must submit all materials by February 12, 2026.

SYA Country Scholars

One applicant from each SYA campus will be selected to receive a scholarship equal to 50% of the tuition.

Legacy Scholarships

Applicants must be a child or sibling of an SYA Graduate. Legacy students can be awarded up to \$10,000 for the year and \$5,000 for the semester.

1964 Scholarships


These scholarships are awarded to a limited number of exceptional students. Awards vary in amount and recipients can receive up to \$15,000.

Halsey Fund Scholar

One full year student will be awarded full tuition along with a stipend for round-trip airfare from Logan airport to the SYA campus. Applicants must qualify for financial aid.

Alvarez Global Scholars

These scholarships are awarded to outstanding public school students. The average award covers more than 50% of tuition. Applicants must attend a public school and qualify for financial aid.
