1. **Risk Reduction:** HMPs help identify hazards and reduce their impacts to protect lives and property.
2. **Cost Savings:** we can avoid costly emergency response and recovery by planning ahead.
3. **Improved Resilience:** HMPs strengthen infrastructure planning for the future.
4. **Eligibility for Funding:** HMPs can make our district eligible for federal and state funding help.
5. **Community Awareness:** HMPs provide information to our community on local risks and ways we can prepare to respond.
