### COMMUNITY

Lake Oswego High School is consistently ranked among the top public high schools in Oregon and in the nation. Lake Oswego has long held a strong reputation for academic excellence. This comprehensive public high school is located in the city of Lake Oswego, approximately 10 miles south of Portland.

### SCHOOL INFORMATION

- Lake Oswego High School is a four-year comprehensive public secondary school that serves approximately 1,300 students in grades 9 through 12
- Accredited by the Northwest Association of Schools and Colleges.
- Approximately 320 students in the Class of 2026
- Offers a challenging course of study, including AP and honors courses, designed for a predominantly college-bound student body.
- District recognizes Seal of Biliteracy; over 30 languages spoken by students.

### 2025-2026 UPDATES

- This year, reductions in funding has resulted in fewer course offerings and increased scheduling conflicts, preventing more students from enrolling in some of their preferred courses.
- Our school has implemented new guidelines limiting students to request only the number of teacher recommendation letters required by institutions.



### GRADING SYSTEM
