Cleora H. Stever Chapter Membership Criteria

To be eligible to apply for membership, students must meet the following criteria:

- Cumulative grade point average of 3.7 at the end of 10th grade.
- Accumulation of at least five activity points through non-credited, school activities (e.g., clubs, sports). Full year participation is equal to one point.
- Verified community service hours--30 total hours if applying in 11th grade. 45 total hours if applying in 12th grade.
- Adherence to the NMHS attendance policy which states: No more than 18 absences (excused or unexcused) the year prior to induction.
- Must be a NMHS for at least 1 semester prior to the induction.
- 1 meeting a month.

The Faculty Committee and/or Principal reserve the right to deny admission to students with excessive lateness to school. A discipline record check of all eligible nominees will also be conducted.

Almost a year after the schools initially shut down, let's take a look back on how the coronavirus affected people in the education system

Is online learning a gain or a loss for the students?

Many people have wondered whether people benefited from having class online, or are suffering because of it. Here are both positive and negative aspects of online learning.

Pros

- Students can conveniently work from any location that they want
- Students do not have to rush in the morning to get to school and are not at interpersonal disadvantages
- Students may benefit from being near family and might feel less social stress as they will not have to interact with people as often
- Students can learn to be more technologically fluent due to their daily interaction with technology, which is becoming a more and more important skill to have.

Cons

- Sitting in front of the computer for an extended period of time can have damage on the student's mental and physical health
- Students with poor will or less efficient technological devices are at a disadvantage
- Students may suffer mentally from being unable to see their friends
- Students may become less acquainted with such activities as taking tests on paper or writing notes/essays by hand.



AAPI Heritage Club


