ACADEMICS

Pingry offers courses at the college-prep and Honors/Advanced Placement/ Advanced Topics levels. The standard academic load is 6 courses and the year is divided into 2 semesters, with some courses yearlong and others a semester or trimester in length. AT courses are AP equivalent or post AP curricula.
