

Senior Homecoming Court Information

Nomination Process:

Step One:

First, you will have to "OPT-IN" to be nominated. This form will be available from 9/29-10/1. You won't be nominating anyone, yet. You will simply be adding your own name if you wish to be on the nomination form.

Step Two:

Once all nominees have been entered, you will then vote for your TOP TEN candidates. Candidate categories are King, Queen, and Royal.

The Top Ten vote receivers will be on the Homecoming Court. 10/6-10/10.

Key points about Step Two:

The balance of the court will be determined by the voting that takes place. You will vote for TEN total candidates, and they can be any combination of King, Queen, and Royal candidates, but there will be a maximum of FIVE candidates from one category on the court.

Ex.

If the Top 7 vote receivers are all QUEEN candidates, the first 5 will be taken, and the final 5 will either be KING, ROYAL, or a combination of the two. This helps solve an unbalanced court.

Step Three:

The Final Two (Either King/Queen, King/Royal, Queen/Royal, or Royal/Royal) will be voted upon by the ENTIRE STUDENT BODY from 10/13-10/15.

Final Notes:

All voting will take place on churchill.voting4schools.com (except the OPT-IN) which will be done via a Google Form.

Anyone on court will need to be present for a rehearsal on Wednesday, October 15th right after school. They will also need to be present at the assembly on Friday, October 17th, the game, and the dance on the 18th.

There is NO OPEN CAMPAIGNING in the school for court. What you do on your own social media is up to you, but there is NO CAMPAIGNING in school.
