## 1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

In the 2024–25 school year, the Fremont Union High School District used AMS Proposition 28 (Arts and Music in Schools) funds to support and expand the District's comprehensive Visual and Performing Arts opportunities for students across our five high schools and our community day school. Districtwide, Prop 28 funding provided courses in Art, Music and Drama. It also supported additional stipends for staff leading after school programs such as marching band, color guard, winter percussion, drama productions, and vocal music. In addition, Prop 28 funds were allocated to supplies and equipment for Art, Music, and Drama programs across all our schools. As required under Proposition 28, this report provides information for the 2024–25 school year, including the number of full-time equivalent teachers, classified personnel, and teaching aides supported; the number of students served; and the number of school sites offering arts education programs funded through AMS.
