Counseling Office Announcements

Seniors, please remember to keep an eye on college application deadlines and reach out to your counselor if you are in need of help. A couple reminders...

• If you are sending ACT or SAT scores to a college as part of your application, check to see if your school requires an official score report. If it does require official score reports for the application process, you must send these directly from www.myACT.org (ACT) or from www.CollegeBoard.org (SAT). Send these at least 3 weeks before application deadlines.

- In SchooLinks.com, make sure to add colleges that you are applying to you will connect your Common App and/or add schools that aren't part of Common App manually in SchooLinks adding schools will auto request your transcripts in SchooLinks. You will need to enter teacher recommendation requests (if required) for each school in SchooLinks. While many schools have November 1st early action deadlines, some out-of-state schools have October 15th deadlines. You'll want to connect with teachers, if your colleges require/allow for rec letters, by the end of September to request any letters for early action deadlines. See your counselor for help with this process.
- You do not need to wait for transcripts and rec letters to be sent for you to be able to click send on your applications. As soon as you are ready to send your application, you can send your portion. Requested transcripts and letters of recommendation will connect with your application materials in your application portal prior to the application date you indicated.
- Within a few hours to a few days after you apply to a college, be sure to look for an email from the college inviting you to login to your applicant portal. You may see additional application tasks to complete here as well as application updates and decisions.
- Track your 6 senior volunteer hours for graduation in SchooLinks too! Click on "School" (apple icon on left side). Click "experience tracking" Enter your volunteer experience details and an email of someone from the organization who can verify your volunteer hours.
- Local scholarships will be updated on SchooLinks.com as they are shared with the counseling office. Typically, most local scholarships are posted in January, February, and March of your senior year.

Reach out to your counselor if you have not scheduled your senior check yet!

Yearbook Announcement:

Yearbooks are on sale now. Seniors have the option to have the book mailed to their house next September rather than having to pick it up here. We strongly suggest you have the book mailed.
