### Freedom of Information Act

In compliance with State Law (5 ILCS 140/4), school districts are required to post information as part of Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requirements on their website.

If the information you seek is not found on the SD74 website ([www.sd74.org](http://www.sd74.org)), you may submit a request to review or obtain copies of public records held by Lincolnwood School District 74. Requests are to be submitted in writing to:

When a written request for information is received, the District must comply within five working days. Under certain circumstances, the response time may be extended for up to five additional working days. If this happens, you will be notified by letter at the end of the first five days specifying the reason for the delay.

The fundamental right guaranteed by the Act is the right of inspection. While you may obtain copies of records requests, you are not required to purchase copies of records to gain access to them. When copies are requested, a public body may charge fees reasonably calculated to reimburse it for the actual cost of reproducing and certifying public records.

#### **Fees for copies**

An invoice will be issued and payment is to be made payable to Lincolnwood School District 74.

- First 50 pages of black and white, letter- or legal-sized copies: **No charge**
- Additional pages after the first 50 pages: **15 cents per page**
- All color copies (including the first 50): **Actual cost for reproducing the records**
- All copies on paper sizes other than letter- and legal-sized: **Actual cost for reproducing the records**
- Copies in electronic format: **Actual cost for purchasing the medium (CD or other)**
- Fee for certifying a public record: **\$1.00**

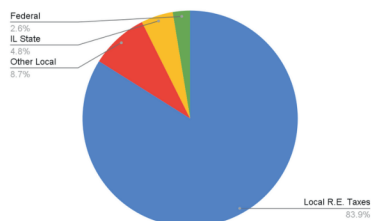
