(Grades: K-4)

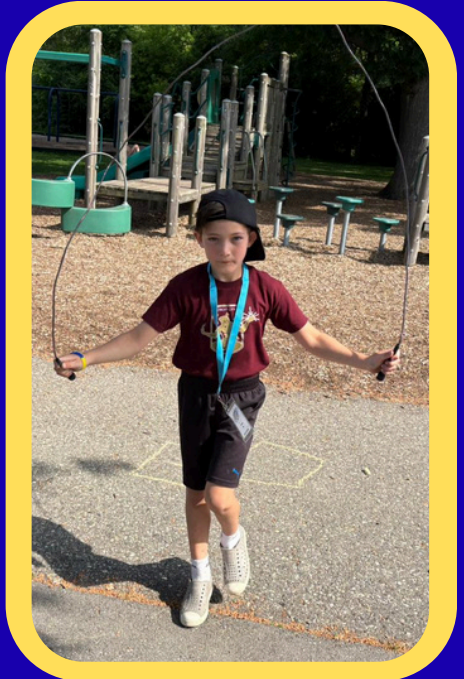

- Be escorted to their Enrichment activities.

Students who are not picked up within ten (10) minutes of the conclusion of their Enrichment class will be signed into Extended Day and billed accordingly. When picking up your child from Enrichment, please use the East Entrance.
