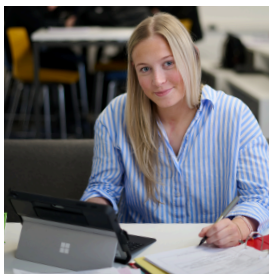


SIXTH FORM SCHOLARSHIPS

Bury Grammar School offers a range of scholarships for students entering the Sixth Form. The true purpose of our scholarships is to recognise the hard work, future potential, and excellence in both academic and enrichment activities of our students while rewarding their commitment to School and our values.

An important part of being a Sixth Form Scholar is the commitment to supporting younger pupils in the given area and representing the School in that field.

Scholarships carry with them a small monetary award. This award is given directly to successful applicants upon them achieving the criteria of their scholarship offer and entering the Sixth Form. Each September, the scholarship assembly is a momentous occasion where we celebrate the achievements of our exceptional students.



ACADEMIC AND SUBJECT SCHOLASHIPS

Subject Scholarships

Subject scholarships are offered in all A Level subjects.

Eligibility Criteria:

- During their time at BGS the student has demonstrated commitment to both the subject and School.
- The student is intending to study the subject at A Level and has read beyond the curriculum;
- The student has studied the subject at GCSE - if offered* - and must achieve a 7/8/9 at GCSE;
- The student is committed to mentoring younger pupils and to be an ambassador for that subject.

*Students who wish to apply for a scholarship in Economics, Politics or Psychology must demonstrate in their application letter that they have a genuine interest and read widely in that subject. Students applying for these subjects would ideally achieve:

- **Politics** - 7/8/9 in History or RS
- **Psychology** - 7/8/9 in Science & one essay-based subject
- **Economics** - 7/8/9 in Mathematics & one essay-based subject.

Academic Scholarships

Academic scholarships will recognise a student's all round academic excellence and achievement.

Eligibility Criteria:

- The student must achieve grades 7 or above in all of their GCSEs;
- The student is committed to enhancing the scholarship scheme within the Sixth Form and promoting scholarships lower down the School.

Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) Scholarships

A number of STEM scholarships are offered and are intended to promote the study of STEM subjects within the Sixth Form.

Eligibility Criteria

- The student will study at least two STEM subjects at A Level and intends to pursue a STEM-related degree;
- The student will, during their time in the Sixth Form at BGS, promote the study of STEM subjects and mentor younger pupils intending to follow similar paths;
- The student will act as an ambassador for a STEM A Level.

Engineering Scholarships

A number of Engineering scholarships are offered and intended to promote the study of Engineering subjects within the Sixth Form.

Eligibility Criteria

- The student will study Mathematics and Physics at A Level and intends to pursue an Engineering-related degree;
- The student will, during their time in the Sixth Form at BGS, promote the studying of Engineering-based subjects and mentor younger pupils intending to follow similar paths;
- The student will act as an ambassador for an Engineering related A Level subject;
- The student will need to achieve grades 7/8/9 in Mathematics and Physics at GCSE.

Medicine, Dentistry and Veterinary Science (MDV) Scholarships

A number of MDV scholarships will be offered and are designed to encourage and support those intending to pursue degrees in Medicine, Dentistry or Veterinary Sciences.

Eligibility Criteria

- The student will study Biology and Chemistry and intends to pursue a degree in Medicine, Dentistry or Veterinary Science;
- The student will, during their time in the Sixth Form at BGS, promote MDV as a degree option and mentor younger pupils intending to follow the same path;
- The student will act as a Year 12 ambassador for Biology or Chemistry;
- The student will need to achieve grades 7-9 in all of their GCSEs.

SPORTING AND ARTS SCHOLARSHIPS

Sporting Scholarships

A number of Sporting scholarships will be offered to reward and further encourage sporting endeavour and achievement.

Eligibility Criteria:

- The student usually competes in their chosen sport at regional or national level;
- The student has demonstrated, and will continue to demonstrate, commitment to school sport;
- The student will act as an ambassador for sport.

Art and Performing Arts Scholarships

A number of Art and Performing Arts scholarships will be offered to reward, celebrate and further encourage creativity within the Sixth Form at BGS.

Eligibility Criteria:

- The student can demonstrate excellence in their chosen discipline - Art, Music, Drama or Dance and prior commitment to their discipline at BGS;
- The student will promote their chosen discipline in the Sixth Form at BGS;
- The student will act as an ambassador for the relevant A Level subject;
- The student will take a relevant Art or Performing Arts A Level in the Sixth Form.



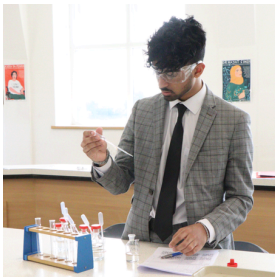
APPLYING FOR A SIXTH FORM SCHOLARSHIP

Students who wish to apply for one or more scholarships should complete the application form and submit this with a letter of application.



Letters of application must explain how the student meets the eligibility criteria for the award/s they are applying for and should be addressed to Mrs Anderson, Principal.

The Senior Leadership Team and Heads of Department will consider applications in January with interviews usually taking place in January alongside Options Interviews. Offers will be made at the beginning of February with offer letters stipulating any conditions that must be met for the successful receipt of the award: this will include any GCSE requirements. The scholarship will be confirmed, and the award paid, upon the candidate successfully meeting the criteria of their scholarship offer and entering BGS Sixth Form.



Any pupil currently attending Bury Grammar Senior School can apply for a maximum of two scholarships. Students will only be considered for scholarships for which they have applied.
