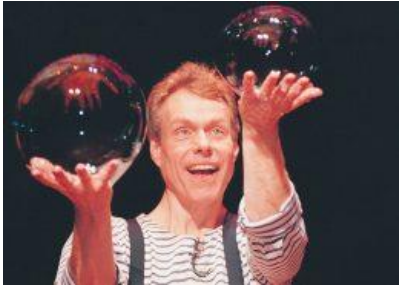


Luther Burbank Center for the Arts Performances

Orchard View students have the opportunity to attend a variety of performances at the Luther Burbank Center for the Arts. The school has purchased seats for the following performances:

November 4th - Tuesday at 9:30AM – *Super Scientific Circus*, recommended for grades 1-6. Super Scientific Circus uses circus skills and magic tricks to showcase scientific principles. With boomerangs, bubbles, bullwhips, rolling globes, spinning plates, and students floating in mid-air, Super Scientific Circus demonstrates and explains complex scientific principles, ranging from friction and inertia to static electricity and magnetism. **Tickets for this performance will be available on October 14th.**



November 20th-Thursday at 9:30 AM – *The Magic School Bus-Lost in the Solar System*, recommended for grades K-5. When Ms. Frizzle’s class gets lost on the way to the planetarium, this extraordinary educator saves the day by blasting into outer space for an epic interplanetary field trip! But when rivalries both old and new threaten to tear the group of students apart, our young heroes must learn to pull together or risk getting forever lost in the solar system. 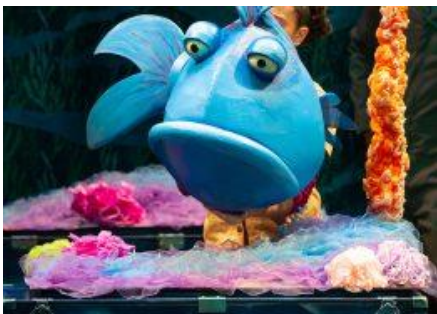
January 20th-Tuesday at 11:30AM – *The Peking Acrobats*, recommended for grades K-12. Hailing from the People’s Republic of China, The Peking Acrobats® bring a 2,000-year-old tradition to the stage, performing daring maneuvers while displaying incredible technical prowess at such arts as trick-cycling, precision tumbling, juggling, somersaulting, and gymnastics. February 26th-Thursday at 9:30AM – *Around the Americas with 123 Andres*, recommended for grades K-3. Their catchy songs and lively performances get the whole audience dancing, singing, and learning! In this fun journey *Around the Americas*, we ask, “¿Dónde está Juana?” We’ll help Andrés find his friend Juana, and our only clue is that she’s somewhere in the Americas.
