**ABOUT THE COMMUNITY**

The East Islip School District is located 50 miles east of New York City on the South Shore of Long Island which includes the communities of East Islip, Islip Terrace, and Great River. The East Islip School District is an economically and culturally diverse community. It serves approximately 4300 students in grades Pre-K through 12 and has approximately 20,000 residents. Two of the district’s schools have been recognized as NYS Rewards Schools (EIHS and Timber Point Elementary School) and one as a Blue-Ribbon School.

**ABOUT THE SCHOOL**

East Islip High School is a comprehensive school accredited by the New York State Board of Regents with an enrollment of approximately 1,230 students in grades 9-12. Currently there are 283 students enrolled in the senior class. Over the last three years East Islip High School received four National Merit Scholar commendations. Lastly, a well-qualified faculty and diverse course offerings supplemented by rich co-curricular programs enable our students to be well prepared for the challenges of college and other post-secondary choices.

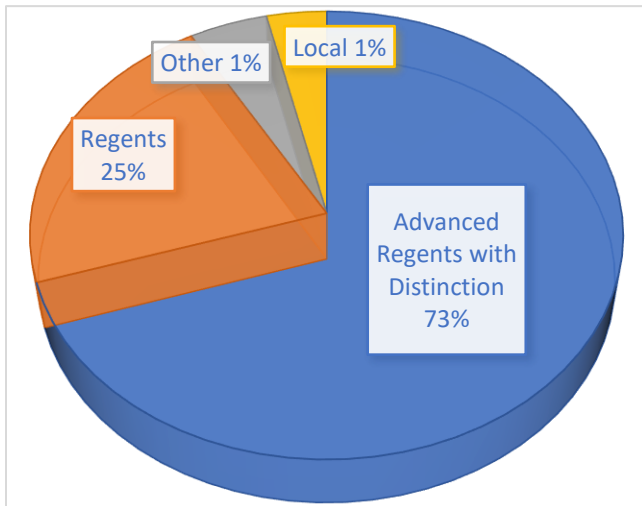

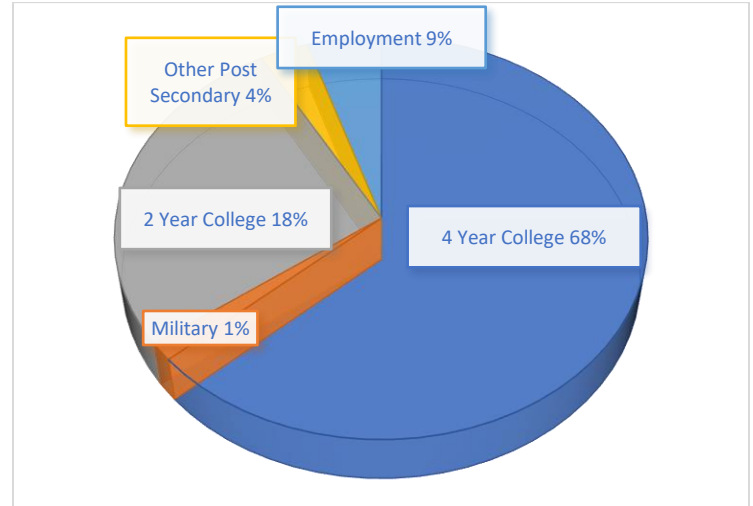
