

To ensure students and families understand the benefits and opportunities for advanced coursework, the Dansville Central School District provides annual notification of advanced coursework to parents and students. Specifics of advanced coursework can be found in the high school course description book, which can be found on the district website at <https://hs.dansvillecsd.org/counseling-1/course-catalog>

Each year in May or June, students/parents in 6th grade are notified of the opportunities associated with accelerated / honors courses in 7th grade. Administration, teachers and school counselors review multiple forms of data to determine appropriate placement. Letters are mailed home in June describing academic opportunities and outlining expectations.

Accelerated and Honors courses challenge students academically. Many advanced courses in grades 10-12 are associated with AP College Board and Genesee Community College. In dual credit courses, students have the opportunity to earn college credit.

Listed below are the initial advanced / honors courses offered at Dansville High School:

7th Grade Accelerated Math:

Allows students to challenge the Integrated Algebra Regents exam in 8th grade and opens up opportunities for multiple college credit bearing math classes as an upperclassman in addition to Pre-Calc, AP Stats, AP Calc.

7th Grade Accelerated Science:

Allows students to challenge the Biology Regents exam in 8th grade and opens up opportunities for multiple college credit bearing science classes in addition to AP Chemistry, AP Physics, AP Biology.

7th grade Honors English:

Allows students to be better prepared for the following year's Honors courses and opens up opportunities for multiple college credit bearing classes in addition to English 10 Honors, AP English 11 and AP English 12.

7th grade Honors Social Studies:

Allows students to be better prepared for the following year's Honors courses and opens up opportunities for multiple college credit bearing classes in addition to AP Modern World History, AP US History, AP Government & Economics, and AP Macro Economics.
