Math

- Count objects and numbers up to 20
- Count to 100 by ones and tens
- Solve simple addition and subtraction within 10
- Identify and describes shapes

- Compare sets of objects (more, less, equal)
- Sort and classify objects by color, size, or shape

Science

- Use senses to explore and describe the world
- Tell the difference between living and non-living things
- Observe weather and seasonal changes
- Ask questions and make predictions
- Describe objects by color, size, texture, and weight
- Identify basic Earth materials like rocks, water, and soil

- Listen to stories and ask and answer questions
