## Math

- Count forwards and backwards up to 120.
- Compare and order whole numbers up to 120.
- Add and subtract within 20 fluently and solve word problems within 20 using strategies.
- Understand place value of tens and ones up to 120.
- Identify, describe, and classify 2D and 3D shapes.
- Identify and extend patterns.
- Understand the meaning of the equal sign.
- Partition shapes into halves and fourths.
- Tell time to the hour and half-hour.
- Count a collection of coins up to one dollar.

## Science

- Ask questions, make predictions, and conduct simple investigations.
- Record and communicate observations using pictures, numbers, and words.
- Classify matter by observational properties (Color, Size, Shape, Texture)
- Describe changes caused by heating or cooling.
- Identify sources of light, heat, and sound.
- Identify seasons, patterns of the day/night sky, and weather changes.
- Identify basic needs of plants and animals.
- Compare living and nonliving things.

## ELAR

- Decode one-syllable words using letter-sound relationships, blends, digraphs, and vowel teams.
- Read grade level texts with accuracy, fluency, and comprehension.
- Understand text features such as titles, headings, illustrations.
- Write short compositions with a clear beginning, middle, and end.
- Use correct capitalization and punctuation.
- Spell words phonetically and begin using conventional spelling patterns.
- Follow multi-step oral directions.
- Engage in discussions, asking and answering relevant questions.

## Social Studies

- Understand that history relates to past events, people, and customs.
- Explain the significance of patriotic holidays and historical figures.
- Use simple maps and globes to locate places.
- Identify landforms such as mountains or bodies of water.
- Recognize authority figures and their roles such as police, teachers or mayor.
- Recite and understand the Pledge of Allegiance and Texas Pledge.
- Identify family and community traditions.
