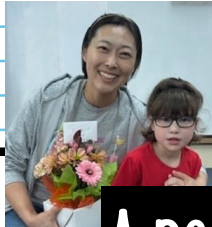
A note from the teacher:

ELA	Heggerty: Rhyme recognition, onset fluency, blending words, isolating final sounds, segmenting words, adding words, deleting words, substituting words and language awareness. Phonics: Sounds for the following letters: m, a, d, t, g and o. We are reading and writing words with these sounds! Comprehension: Describe the 5 senses and recall facts about the 5 senses.
PURPOSEFUL PLAY CENTERS	Create: Mr. Potato Head 5 Senses Investigate: STEM Bins Explore: Play dough Textures Pretend: Eye Doctor Build: Shakers
MATH	Unit 2: Students are answering "how many" questions and developing their understanding of the connection between quantities and spoken numbers. Students are also developing their comparison skills using comparison terms such as "more" and "fewer."
