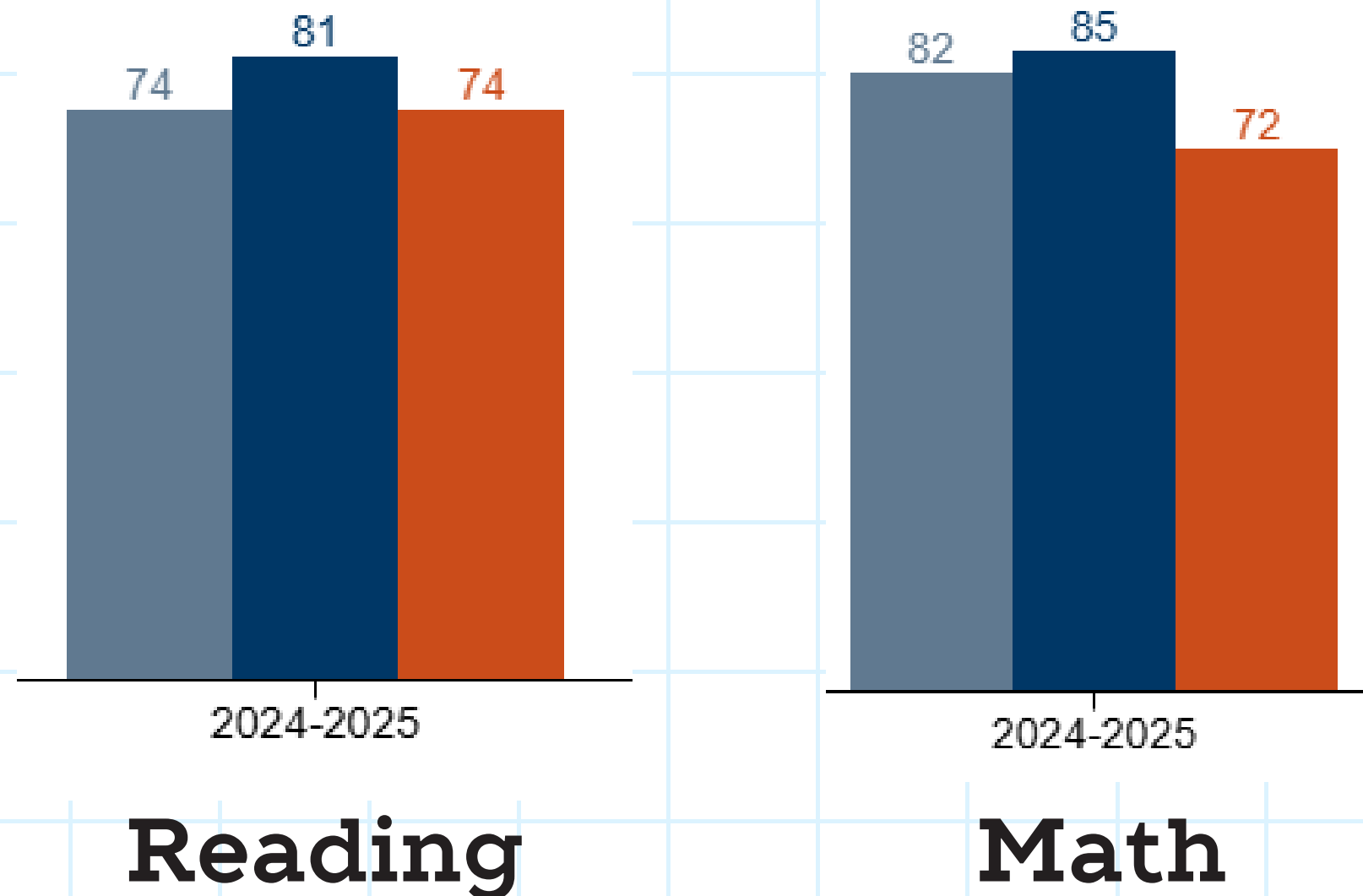


What is the purpose of the Title 1 Program at New Kent Elementary School?

- The purpose of Title I is to provide **all** children significant opportunity to receive a fair, equitable, and high-quality education, and to close educational achievement gaps.
- Title I, Part A; Improving Basic Programs Operated by Local Educational Agencies provides financial assistance through state educational agencies to school divisions and public schools with high numbers or percentages of children from low-income families to help ensure that all children meet challenging state academic content and achievement standards.
- NKES' is a school-wide program designed to support and increase achievement for all of our students.
- While all students, K-5, benefit from our Title I program, a large portion of our funds are dedicated to supporting students who are not meeting challenging state academic and achievement standards.

School Wide Plan

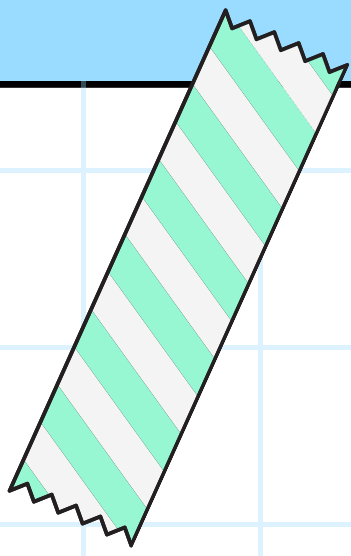


Reading: Students in grades Kindergarten through 5th grade will increase their ability to comprehend grade level text as evidenced by the following: an overall SOL (grades 3-5) pass rate of 85% and 20% or less of students with an identified indicator in the subtest of Passage Retell for VALLSS (grades K-2).



Math: Students in grades 3rd through 5th will increase their overall pass rate on the math SOL from an 82% to 90%.

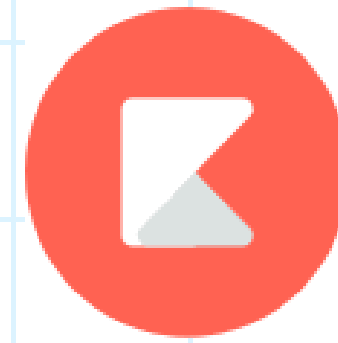




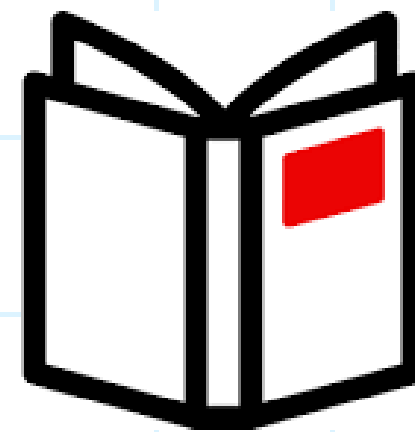

Our Title I events this year include, but are not limited to:

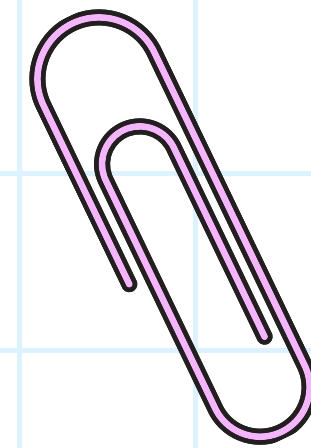
