School Calendar

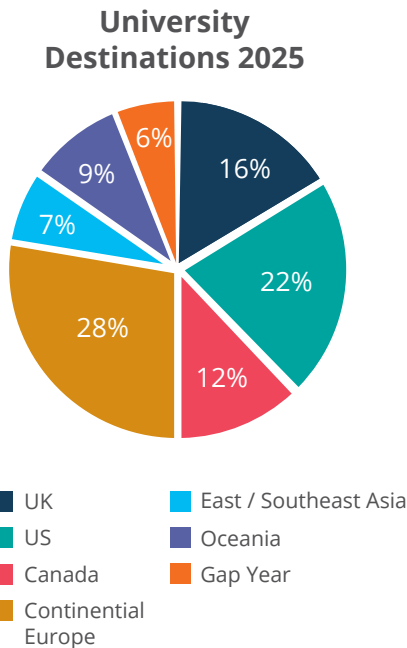
The school operates a 180-day calendar, running from mid-August to mid-June. The school year is divided into three terms.

School and Community

Taipei European School (TES) is an independent, co-educational day school, which was formed through the amalgamation of The Taipei British School (TBS), Ecole Française de Taipei (EFT) and Deutsche Schule Taipei (DST).

It now operates as a single European entity through a non-profit making Foundation. A rapidly-expanding school, TES is now home to 1800 students from 50 different nationalities. The high school section has 426 students in total.

12 Maximum University Application Policy - TES has adopted a 12 university application cap policy this year. This is to ensure that students make a conscientious and deliberate decision when finalising their university list.

➤ Middle Year Programme

Students in years 7 to H2 in the British Secondary and High School section will complete the five-year International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme (MYP). Students take subjects in Language and Literature (English and Chinese), Language Acquisition (Chinese and a choice of French, German or Spanish), Individuals and Societies, Science, Mathematics, Design, Physical and Health Education and The Arts (Theatre, Music, Visual Arts).

➤ International Baccalaureate Curriculum and Results

H3 and H4 students (Year 12 and Year 13) complete a two-year International Baccalaureate programme, the Diploma Programme or Career-related Programme. Diploma Programme students take six subjects, three of which are at Higher Level and three of which are at Standard Level. Career-related Programme students complete a course in conjunction with one of our university partners in addition to three or four Diploma subjects.

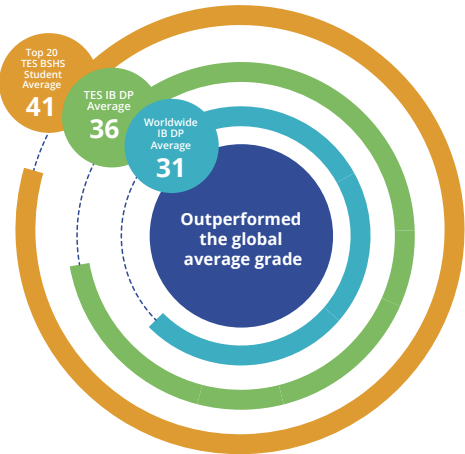

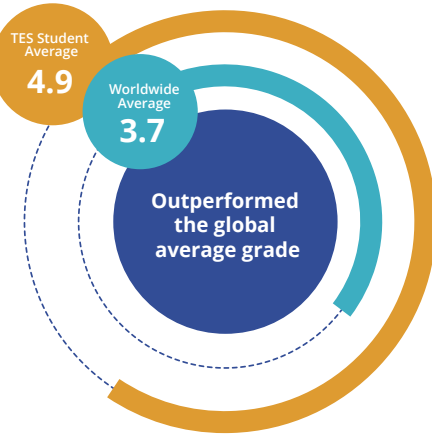
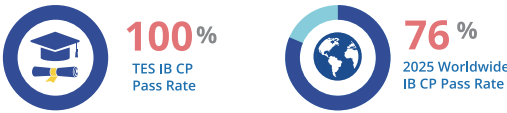

➤ The Taipei European School French Section, The Lycée Française de Taipei (LFT) Curriculum and Results

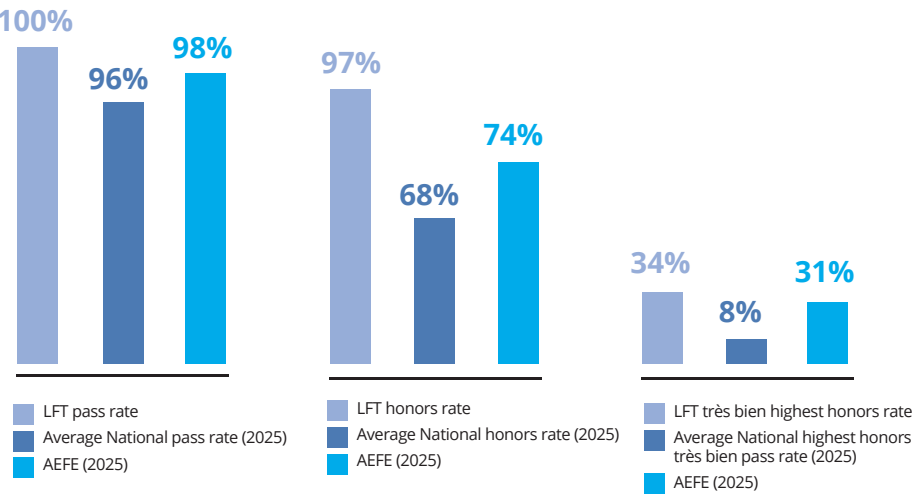
The Lycée Française de Taipei (LFT) (French Section) follows the French national curriculum, leading to the Diplôme National du Brevet in 3ème (Year 10) and the Baccalauréat in Première and Terminale (Years 12 and 13). In Première, students choose three specialties, narrowed to two in Terminale. The International Section begins in 2nde (Year 11), and eligible students may pursue the BFI (Baccalauréat Français International) in Première—an advanced bilingual track with enriched English coursework in language, literature, and history-geography. The BFI offers academic depth and international focus comparable to the IB or AP, preparing students for top global universities.
