The Edgemont Union Free School District has submitted information to the New York State Education Department regarding asbestos containing building materials in the school district. This information is documented in the school district's Asbestos Management Plan, which is in accordance with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) of 1987 (40 CFR Part 763). This memorandum is intended to fulfill annual notification requirements.

In compliance with the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), the Edgemont Union Free School District has been inspected for asbestos-containing building materials. The EPA and the New York State Education Department require us to conduct re-inspections of the building every three years and the school district continues to perform the six month periodic surveillances. An EPA/NYS accredited Inspector/Management Planner performed the inspections in August 2025, and recommended actions to safely manage the asbestos materials in our buildings.

The Asbestos Management Plan for the Edgemont UFSD is located in the District Office with the Director of Facilities and is available to the public for review Monday through Friday from 9 A.M. - 3 P.M. Each school office within the district also maintains a copy of its Asbestos Management Plan that is available for viewing Monday through Friday 9 A.M. - 3 P.M.
