RE: Annual Notice of Health Care Services Accessible to Students

Dear Parent/ Guardian,

Pursuant to Ohio Rev. Code 3313.473(B)(4), we write to inform you of the health care services offered at or facilitated in cooperation with District schools. Health care services include physical, behavioral, or mental health care services, but, health care services do not include emergency situations, first aid, other unanticipated minor health care services, or health care services provided pursuant to a student's IEP or 504 Plan. As a parent, you may withhold consent or decline care on behalf of your child for health care services listed below by submitting your request in writing to the building principal. Please note that withholding consent or declining access to services will *not* waive your right to access your child's educational or health care records. Thank you for your attention to this matter.

School Nurse	Hearing Screening	State law requires the District to conduct hearing screenings on kindergarten students.	Private Provider or Community Health Center
School Nurse	Vision Screening	State law requires the District to conduct vision screenings on kindergarten students.	Private Provider or Community Health Center
District Speech-Language Pathologist	Speech/Language Screening	State law requires the District to conduct speech/language screenings on kindergarten students.	Private Provider or Community Health Center
School Nurse	Health Care /Diabetes Care	State law requires BOE/District to provide appropriate diabetes care to enrolled students who have diabetes.	Private Provider or Community Health Center
School Nurse	General Health Care	State law permits the District to appoint a nurse but does not require BOE/District to appoint or contract health care providers	Private Provider or Community Health Center
School Social Worker, School Counselors	Mental Health Counseling; Behavioral Support	State law does not require the District to provide this service.	Private Provider or Community Health Center
School Psychologist	Mental Health Counseling; Behavioral Support	State law does not require the District to provide this service.	Private Provider or Community Health Center
Teachers, School Counselors, School Psychologists, School Nurse, BCBA	IDEA- or 504-Plan Qualifying Disability Assessment/ Evaluation	State law requires the District to provide these services.	Private providers
