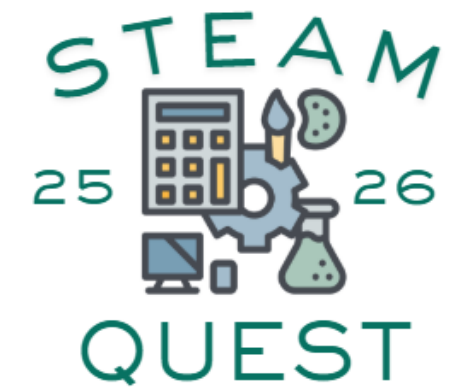
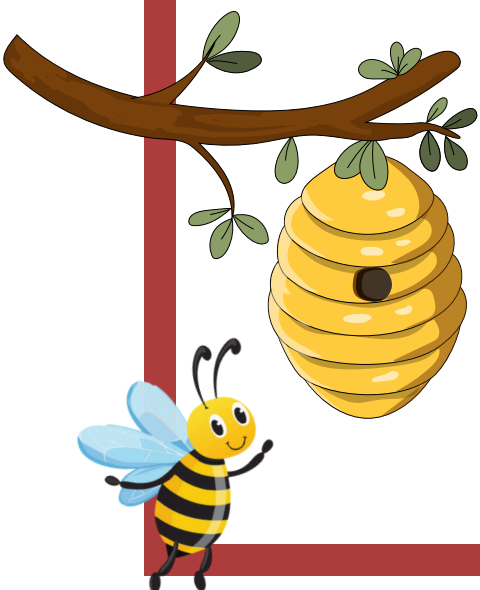


WHAT IS STEAMQUEST?

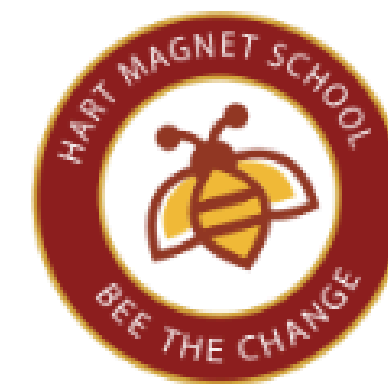
WHAT YOU CAN DO AT HOME?
