

# NURSE'S CORNER



### The Time is Near...

School starting & colder weather coming tends to increase our illness numbers unfortunately. Here are some things you can do to help keep your family healthy during respiratory illness season:

#### 1. Wash your Hands.

Teach your kids to take the full 20 seconds to scrub their hands. Have them perform hand washing the same way every time & it becomes an easy habit!

#### 2. Cover your Cough

Even small kids can put their coughs and sneezes into their elbows. We talk about not letting our "monsters" get to our friends.

#### 3. Avoid Touching our Face

The most common route for those yucky germs to get to us is through our noses, mouth & eyes. Encourage your students to not touch their face so those germs don't have a bigger chance of getting in.

#### 4. Get the Yearly Influenza Vaccine

Yep kids don't like shots, but the yearly influenza vaccine will decrease a child's symptoms and lower chances of death by 50-65%, even if it's not the exact strain!

And it is covered by insurance!

#### 5. Stay Home when Sick

In the school office we work hard to have our students here as much as possible but with symptoms such as fever over 100.4F, sore throat and cough we ask that students stay home for 24 hours from when the fever breaks without medication and your child is feeling better.


## PTO WANTS YOU TO KNOW
