DUAL ENROLLMENT TIMELINE:

JUNE 1 - OCTOBER 29

APPLICATION, TESTING & ADVISING WINDOW

DSC application, testing, required orientation and new student advising session should be completed during this timeframe.

OCTOBER 30

REGISTRATION FOR SPRING 2026 OPENS

Students can begin submitting completed dual enrollment forms with course requests.

DECEMBER 5

SPRING REGISTRATION REQUEST DEADLINE

Application, testing, advising, and course selections should be made, and completed forms need to be submitted by this date to be eligible for enrollment.


WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Dual Enrollment is available to students who are enrolled in an eligible public or private school, home education, or PEP program.

To qualify, students must:

- Be enrolled in grades 6-12
- Earn minimum GPA (completed at least one high school level course)
- Meet minimum placement scores

The Dual Enrollment Process

1

Join a Parent/Student Information Session - Learn about eligibility requirements, steps to qualify, as well as Q&A, then discuss readiness with parent and school counselor.



2

Complete a DSC Admissions Application - Once completed, you will receive an email with your DSC student ID and account details.



3

Take a Placement Test - Once you have a DSC ID number, visit a DSC Assessment Office on any campus for placement testing. Already have test scores? Submit them with your Dual Enrollment Form.



4

Complete Orientation and New Student Advising Session - Complete orientation, then schedule a new student advising session for an overview of programs, how to select courses, important dates, and dual enrollment guidelines.



5

Submit Completed Dual Enrollment Form by the Deadline - Identify your course requests, then review your selections with your parent and school counselor to receive their signatures. Student must submit completed form to DualEnrollment@DaytonaState.edu.
