Changes in Tutoring (From HB 4545 to HB 1416)

Students that qualify for accelerated learning (tutoring) must be provided with the following:

Assigned a TIA teacher for the school year in the required subject area

OR

- High Impact supplemental instruction aligned with TEKS for the grade level/subject area that applies:
 - No less than 15 or 30 hours* depending on student performance. This includes summer or at least once per week in the school year

Limited to two subjects per year, prioritizing Math and Reading

- Minimum of 4 students and a maximum of 10
- students for small group instruction Provided with trained in-person instruction and/or high quality effective instructional materials
- ALC Committee meetings are not required

*HB 1416 requires TEA to define requirements for students requiring 30 hours of supplemental instruction through the rulemaking process. TEA will propose rules that will provide that students who fall into the "Low Does Not Meet" category of STAAR performance receive no less than 30 hours of supplemental instruction. The rules will also provide that students in 3rd grade who do not approach grade level or higher will be required to receive 30 hours of supplemental instruction.
