#### 1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

Ocean View School District serves Preschool–8th grade students across 13 public schools and offers a comprehensive, innovative arts education program at both the elementary and middle school levels. During the 2024–2025 academic year, Proposition 28 funds supported program expansion through the addition of an itinerant elective dance teacher serving two middle schools and hired two itinerant art teachers that worked with 3rd–5th grade students, further broadening access to visual and performing arts. To strengthen theater education, classified staff provided an after school technical support class for a middle school theater, enabling students to produce and run live performances. At the elementary level, one teacher integrated reading instruction with theatrical scripts, allowing struggling readers to act out performances that built both literacy and confidence. These innovative approaches demonstrate how the District leverages arts funding to create meaningful, hands-on learning experiences for students. Ocean View School District remains deeply committed to nurturing student talent and ensuring all students have access to diverse, high-quality arts experiences that contribute to a well-rounded education.
