### **School Goals**

- **K-2 Reading-Increase students performing at proficient level or above 6 percentage points from 25% to 31% on STAR and Waggle Math-Increase students performing at the proficient level or above by 6 percentage points from 11% to 17% on STAR and Waggle 3-5 Reading-Increase students performing at the proficient level or above by 6 percentage points from 10% to 16% on the 2026 Georgia Milestones. Math-Increase students performing at the proficient level or above by 6 percentage points from 14% to 20% on the 2026 Georgia Milestones**

L.H. Williams Elementary will also offer opportunities for full participation for parents with limited English, parents with disabilities and parents of migratory children.

**Where is the plan available?** The plan is included in the Parent and Family Engagement Guidebook that is given to all students at the beginning of the school year. The plan will also be posted on the school website and made available in the school's front office, media center and Parent Resource Center (Room 207).
