### **Book Care**

We have been stressing the importance of good book care with students. Please help reinforce with your child how important it is to take good care of their books. Review with your child how they can care for their library books. Some of the things students can do to take care of their books are:

- Carry books to and from school in your Bee Bag in your backpack.
- Protect your book in your Bee Bag or plastic bag, especially if you carry a cold lunch (sometimes food can leak).
- Handle a book with clean hands only.
- Do not eat or drink while reading your book.
- Keep books away from pets or babies that may damage them.
- Turn pages at the corners to prevent rips.
- Keep books in your backpack when you're not reading them so they don't get lost.
- Write library days on a calendar as a reminder.
