 - Once your contact information is updated click the 'Save and Back' button.
- 2. Please note, parents and guardians must personally log in to Skyward to make these updates. SPS staff cannot update this information for you.

Opting in for text notifications:

After updating your phone, email and text contacts you will still need to opt-in via text message to receive text notifications.

To do this, simply text 'Yes' or 'Y' to the number 67587.

- You must opt-in to receive text alerts.
- Texts are often used to draw attention to important emails
- Texts are always sent if school is canceled.

Annual Notice of Teacher Qualifications

Salina Public Schools is proud of our record of employing the highest quality teachers and paraprofessional available. As a parent or guardian, you have the right to inquire about the professional qualifications of all instructional staff serving your child. Specific information is available from your school's principal at any time throughout the year.

All Title Schools are required to make available the following information upon parent or guardian request:

- Whether the State of Kansas has licensed or qualified the teacher for the grades and/or subjects taught.
- Whether the teachers is teaching under an emergency permit or other provisional status through which Kansas licensing criteria have been waived.
- The teacher's college major and subject of any advanced degrees.
- Whether any instructional aides or paraprofessionals provide services to the child and, if so, the qualification of those staff members.

Notice of Assessment

Our school receives Title 1 funds. Schools that receive these funds are expected to provide to each parent information on the level of achievement and academic growth of the student, if applicable and available, on the Kansas Assessments. Students in grades 3-5 take the Kansas Assessments each Spring. Your child's Kansas Assessment Results will be sent home in your child's grade card at the end of the school year.

The results of the Kansas Assessments are important to our school because we use them to evaluate the effectiveness of our educational programming. As a parent/guardian, you do have the right to opt out of the Kansas Assessments by sending a written request to the building principal stating that you wish for your child to not be tested. Please contact the building principal for more information.
