PARENTS RIGHT-TO-KNOW

Dear Parents and Families:

In compliance with the requirements of the Every Students Succeeds Act, parents of Title I schools have the right and may request information regarding the professional qualifications of their child's classroom teacher. This information regarding the professional qualifications of classroom teachers including, at a minimum, the following:

- 1. Whether the teacher has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction.
- 2. Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived.
- 3. The baccalaureate degree major of the teacher and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher, and the field of discipline of the certification or degree.
- 4. Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.

If at any time, your child has been taught for 4 or more consecutive weeks by a teacher not highly qualified, the school will notify you.

Our teachers are committed to helping your child develop the academic knowledge and critical thinking he/she needs to succeed in school and beyond. I encourage you to support your child's education and communicate with his or her teacher on a regular basis. By partnering, families and educators can provide your child with the best education possible.
