1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

Our district has expanded and strengthened its performing arts offerings through Prop 28 credentialed teachers at both the elementary and middle school levels. Elementary Schools (Grades 4 and 5) Each student receives yearlong performing arts instruction (38 weeks, compared to the prior 24 weeks). The program was divided into one semester of Music followed by one semester of Theater, ensuring exposure to multiple disciplines. In addition to the school-day program, after-school performing arts sessions were offered at every elementary school, taught by our credentialed performing arts teachers. Middle Schools A credentialed Prop 28 Performing Arts Teacher provides Drama instruction during the school day. Drama was taught in two class sections/periods at each middle school. This addition complemented the existing music and visual arts classes, strengthening the middle school arts pathway.
