



Heritage Elementary Traffic Flow Procedures and Safety Reminders



At Heritage we do everything with safety in mind. We keep vehicle and foot traffic as separate as possible. The green arrows show where pedestrians can walk. **Please always use the crosswalks in front of Door 1. DO NOT cut through traffic.** We teach children that we all follow rules and it sets a good example when parents/guardians follow those rules as well. Red lines show vehicle traffic flow. There are two lanes entering the parking lot. Traffic can turn right or left off of Swan Road to enter the lot. **The far right lane continues to the drop-off zone in front of school. This is for drop-off only. If space opens up in front of you, please continue to move forward before dropping your child off.** Traffic can get bottle-necked quickly, especially in bad weather. Always moving forward allows far more traffic to enter the parking lot. **The drop-off lane is for a quick drop-off only as we need to keep the drop-off traffic moving quickly. This entails the driver staying in their vehicle and the student/s leaving the vehicle within a few seconds.** If a quick drop-off isn't feasible for your child, you should park in the lot and walk your child through the parking lot to school. All vehicles should proceed slowly through this area and stop for the crossing guard. Vehicles approaching the crosswalk from the parking lanes must stop as well. When we see accidents occur it's because people aren't following the rules. Running in between vehicles, dropping off students while double-parked in traffic, and crossing outside of the crosswalk can cause problems.



There is also a drop-off area on Swan Road. This area is indicated with the yellow circle on the map. This area does not allow parking or double-parking. If you need to leave your vehicle with your child to walk to their line, park in the parking lot. There is signage along Swan Road stating that there is no parking from 7am-4pm Monday-Friday. The far lot, marked in red, is where our school buses and daycare vans drop-off students and for those purposes only. Please keep this area open for those vehicles. This area is also zoned for recess use during the day for students, thus it cannot be used as a parking lot.

It is a good idea to always plan for some extra time in case of traffic congestion and remember that safety always comes first. **During peak times, our lot may be full so you may need to park on Swanstone Circle or Paint Horse Trail (there is no Parking on either side of Swan Road in front of the school) so that is another reason it is important to plan extra time for dropoff/pickup.** Thank you for your cooperation with these rules and regulations, we are all responsible for following the rules to keep Heritage students safe.
