SCHOOL & COMMUNITY

- Located on an 18,000 sqm campus in western Singapore, offering sports facilities, modern classrooms, and performing arts spaces.
- Founded in 1993 as a non-profit, private American-curriculum school. Fluency in English required for admission.
- 350+ students from 27 nationalities, PreK-12, with expatriate parents in industries like finance, education, business, petrochemicals, the US military, and government embassies.
- Experienced faculty with 60 teachers from 10 countries, mostly US passport holders, averaging 11.3 years of experience, with 57% holding master's degrees or higher.
- Active parent organization coordinates many school events throughout the year.
- Collaborates with local communities, special needs schools, elder care, and government for service projects.

Standards-Based Learning and Assessment

ICS uses a standards-based approach for reporting student learning in the high school. In each course, teachers cover a variety of standards and rate student performance against grade-level standards based on the following scale.

GPA is a cumulative, weighted system where AP courses add 1 point and Honors courses add 0.5 points. Class rank is not calculated.

ICS offers up to 70 high school courses each year, including 20 to 22 AP options, depending on student interest. Over the course of high school, students may take up to 10 AP courses in total.

Courses are structured in a 80-minute block schedule with four class blocks and one advisory period each day. A semester course earns 0.5 credits, while a full-year course earns 1.0 credit. All classes meet four times within a seven-day cycle.

Because the master course schedule is created anew each year, not every class can always fit a student's schedule. In these cases, students may take the needed course through ICS sister school, NorthStar Academy, NorthStar is a Cognia-accredited online school that follows an American curriculum. Grades and credits earned through NorthStar Academy are included.



Advanced Placement & SAT Performance

In 2025, 57 students took 141 AP exams, with enrollment based on meeting prerequisites and teacher recommendations. Our students continue to shine, consistently performing above global averages on both AP and SAT assessments.

- AP Success: The average AP score was 4.21.
- PSAT Participation: Students take the PSAT from Grades 9 through 11
- SAT Excellence: About 92% of the Class of 2026 took the SAT, with an average score of 1348, well above global average of 1050.
