How do I order my transcript?

Parchment.com

If you are applying to **UC/CSU**: You only order **ONE** transcript at the **end of your Senior year**.

If you are applying through **Common App**:

- Be sure to send the transcript to "The Common Application First Year" - NOT to each individual university.
- You must order a transcript 3 times:
 - when you submit their application (Fall),
 - when your Fall grades are posted (January),
 - and at the end of your Senior year (June).

If you are going through **NCAA**: You must order a transcript through Parchment.com to go directly to NCAA.



What is the process for Letters of Rec?

The letters of recommendation Google Form can be found on the website

Guidance > College Planning > Letters of Recommendation

When is my LOR Google Form due to my counselor?

- Is your application due in **November** or **December**? Form is due by **September 26** by 3:30 pm
- Is your application due in **January** or later? Form is due by **October 31** by 3:30 pm

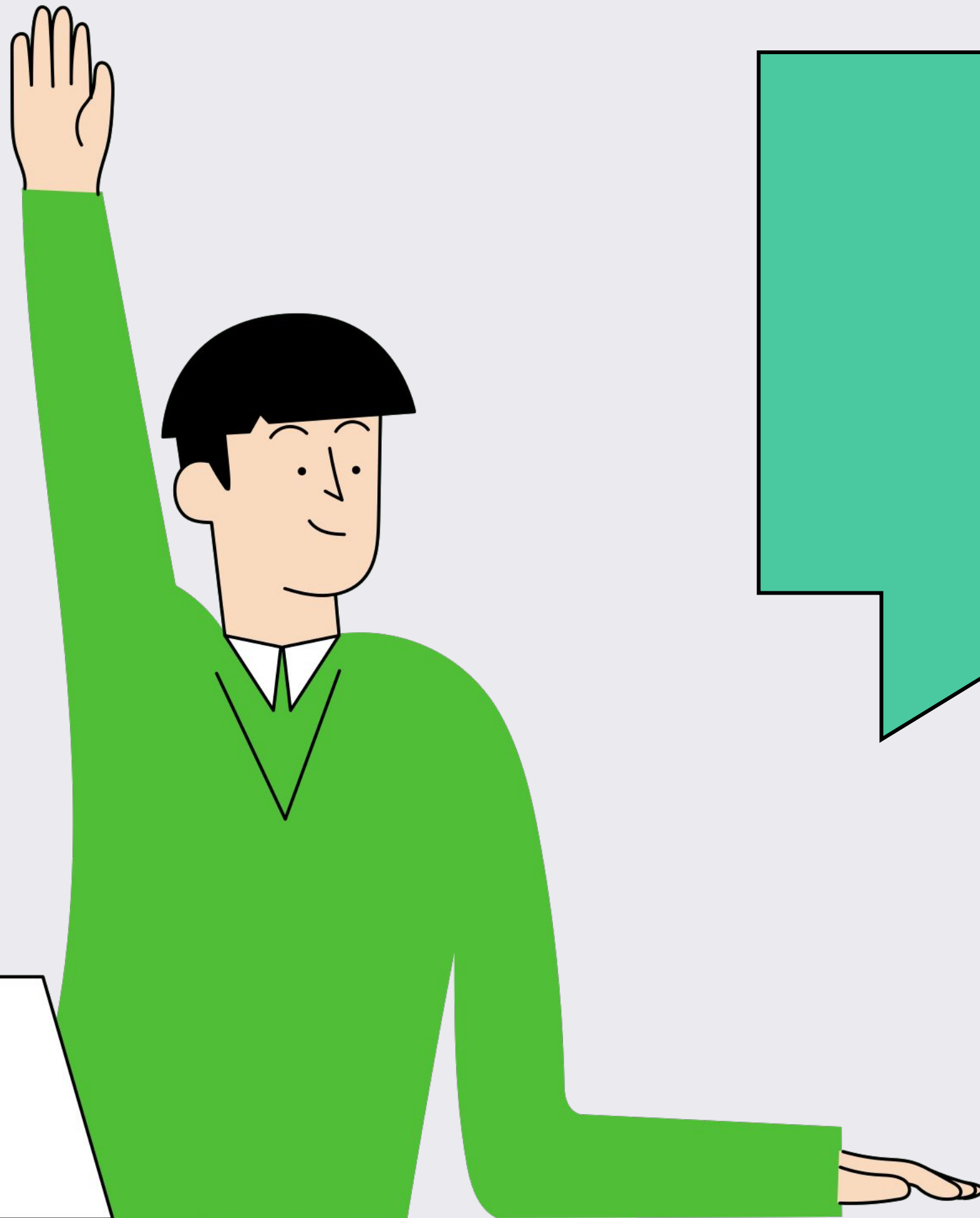



- Must be U.S. Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident
- Must have valid Social Security Number

CADAA

California Dream Act Application

- AB 540 student, undocumented, or DACA
 - Or attended CA high school for 3+ years

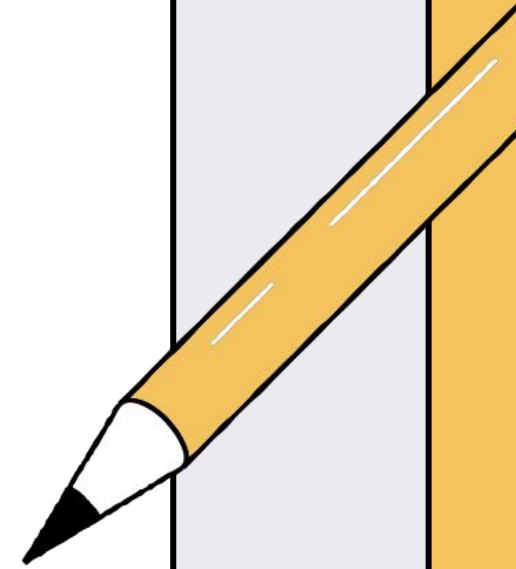

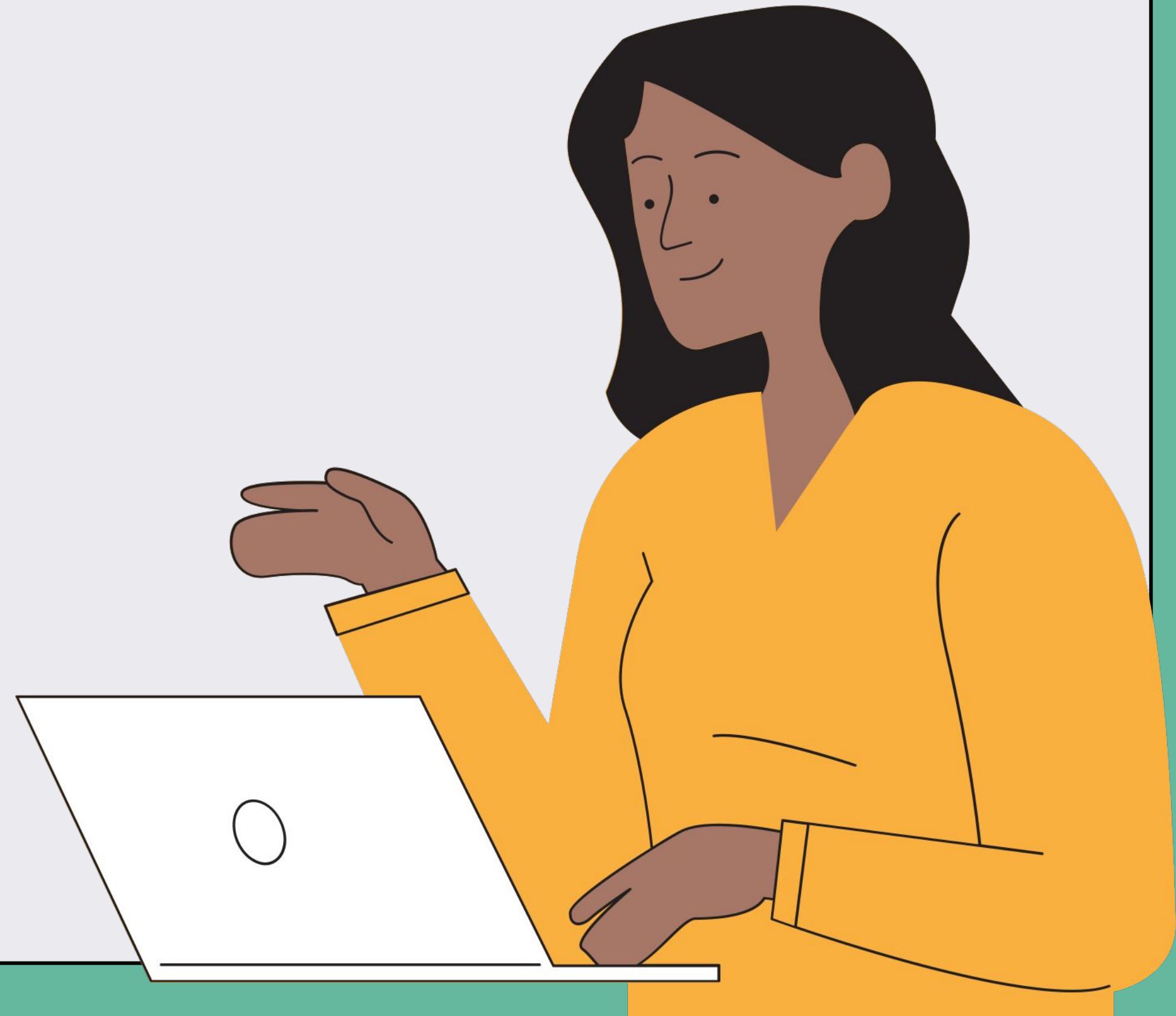


College Application Day

Preparation

- Create/update your personal email
- Check your student and personal email DAILY
- Ensure your college list is final in California Colleges
- Create an account with the application site
- Bring the following information: Social Security Number (if available), Personal Email, Birth Date
