THE FOLLOWING RULES APPLY TO COSTUMES:

1. No clothing with obscene or inappropriate words or pictures.
2. All tops for students should cover the midriff, back, and shoulder areas; all shorts/skirts should be of appropriate length.
3. Costume attire should not cause a disruption during the school day or be unsafe.
4. No fake weapons or other large hand-held items (such as brooms) may be carried as part of the costume.
5. Masks or face paint cannot cover the entire face - this is a safety issue. We must be able to recognize a student.
6. Wigs and/or hats are permitted only if it is part of the costume (i.e. baseball player, etc).
7. No helmets or shoulder pads can be worn (ex: football gear).
