The journey begins at Summit Technology Academy, where aspiring nurses gain a solid foundation in science, math, and healthcare fundamentals. High school students in this program receive specialized training, real world learning experiences, and education to help them excel in their future nursing studies.

\$ SAVE MONEY

Students receive a 50% discount on the cost of tuition for classes taken at MCC while in high school, saving students significant overall costs on their nursing education. Students must live in an MCC attendance area to receive the tuition discount.

Students receive a strong foundation in healthcare knowledge, ethics, and skills, setting them up for success in their nursing studies. Partnering with renowned healthcare institutions, these nursing programs offer a wide range of clinical opportunities, enhancing students' practical skills.




SAVE TIME

Students have the option to pursue a 2- or 3-year pathway to earn their Associate of Arts (AA) degree, beginning in their junior year of high school, while also fulfilling the prerequisites for the nursing program. After graduating high school, they will be able to complete their Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree within 2 to 3 years.
