

# North Star House Rules

## Photo ID

Photo ID is required for entry into all Bethel School District buildings—every visit, every time. This ensures the safety of our students and staff.

## Early Sign Out

To minimize disruption to learning, students stay in their classrooms until parents/guardians arrive for early sign-out. After identification is presented and authorization confirmed, your child will be called to the office. Please plan a little extra time for them to gather their belongings and come to the office.

## Electronic Devices (cellphones, watches etc.)

We understand that parents may want to communicate with their children during the day, but cell phones, watches, and other electronic devices are not allowed during school hours. If a student needs to reach an authorized adult (for illness, anxiety, or other concerns), they may do so with an approved district device under adult supervision.

To help your child be comfortable, we suggest keeping an extra set of clothes in their backpack. If clothing is needed during the school day and no spare set is available, students will be sent to the health room and a parent/guardian will be contacted. We also do not have coats available for cold weather, so please be sure your child comes dressed appropriately.
