Notes from the School Nurse

Medications at School

If your child will need to take medication at school, a medication administration form is required for ALL medications. Over-the-counter medications that are given as directed per the original bottle need only a parent signature on the form. Prescription medications and over-the-counter medications that are given differently than directed on the original bottle will require both a parent and prescribing physician signature before medication can be given at school, so please plan ahead.

Conferences are scheduled using Conference Manager, an on-line conference scheduling program being used by the Ashwaubenon School District. The link for the Conference Manager site is located at: <https://ashwaubenon.schoolsoft.com>. If you have already registered online for conferences last school year, you can log into Conference Manager using the email and password you created. The Conference Manager website has a "forgot password" link if needed. If you are new to the school district or if you did not register online for conferences last year, you must first register by clicking "Register Now" on the login page. You may register or edit your account at any time but you may only book conferences once the conference scheduling window has opened.

In addition to your child's classroom teacher, you may register to meet with the phy ed and/or music teacher during conferences (5K only). When scheduling with the phy ed or music teacher, please list the student's classroom teacher in the comments section. Specials teachers this year are:

Medicamentos en la escuela
