Architect Selection

The Woodstock Academy Board of Trustees must continuously strive to provide new facilities and/or timely renovation that will provide the best educational experience for all students within fiscal constraints. To assist the Board in the accomplishment of this objective, an architect will be commissioned for every major building or renovation project initiated by the Board.

In selecting an architect, the following criteria may be considered:

- Training and experience including that of partners and associates
- Planning ability and promptness
- Specification writing, accuracy and sufficiency of detail
- Design, appearance and utility
- Inspection of job effectiveness
- Relation with contractors

The Board will appoint an Architect Selection Committee or use the Buildings and Grounds Committee to select an architect for each project. The Head of School will make the final determination of the architect to be recommended to the Committee.
