Automatic External Defibrillator

The Woodstock Academy strives to provide a safe environment for students, staff, parents, and community as they learn and recreate in The Academy facilities. In achieving a safe environment, automatic external defibrillators (AED) are maintained at The Academy. The AED shall be used in situations warranting its use by individuals specifically trained in the application of the device. Such training shall be in accordance with the standards set forth by the American Red Cross or the American Heart Association. Only individuals who have the required initial training and recurrent training as specified by state law and regulations and as advised by the school medical advisor will administer the device.

The AEDs will be in places designated by the Head of School or his/her designee in conjunction with recommendations by medical professionals. The defibrillators shall be maintained and tested in accordance with the operational guidelines of the manufacturer and monitored by the Health Office.

Students who inappropriately access and/or use an AED will be deemed to have violated the school's conduct code and subject to disciplinary action.
