

Instruction**Earning College Credit While Enrolled at The Academy**College Placement

The Board of Trustees encourages students to advance academically at a pace appropriate for them. Therefore, it shall permit the Head of School, or his/her designee, the ability to allow Academy-enrolled students the option of taking college courses for elective credit, either on a full- or part-time basis, for high school seniors who are exceptionally able and motivated academically and who are ready socially/emotionally.

When such individual elective program is requested by a student and meets with the approval of the Head of School and his/her designee, and have been formally reviewed by the Academic Committee, the student may be released from high school attendance on a full- or part-time basis, and shall be awarded an Academy diploma after evidence is received that she/he has met, through college work, all necessary academic requirements for graduation.
