

Instruction**Early Graduation**

Recognizing that a four-year high school education is of critical academic importance to the students served by The Woodstock Academy, it shall be the policy of the Board of Trustees that no student unless specifically exempted through a duly and legally called Planning and Placement Team meeting or approved by the Head of school for some extraordinary circumstances, shall be allowed to graduate from The Woodstock Academy in less than four full school years. Students wishing to graduate a year early must complete the required process by the end of 4 semesters. Students wishing to graduate a semester early must complete the required process by the end of 5 semesters. Any and all students shall be required to meet the approved graduation requirements and meet with the Academic Committee. Additionally, students graduating a year early, will not be allowed to take part in any senior activities unless approved by the Head of School.

Within their senior year, all students shall be enrolled in no less than three credits per semester and be required to pass no less than five courses in addition to or combined with the graduation requirements, unless approved by the Head of School.
