Special Education

The Board of Trustees accepts its legal duties and responsibilities for providing special education programs and services for students attending The Woodstock Academy.

The Head of School is directed to develop a comprehensive plan for compliance with all of the requirements of federal and state law for the education of all individuals with exceptional needs attending The Woodstock Academy in accordance with individual IEPs.

The comprehensive plan should be in alignment with the financial requirements of Policy 3240.1 (Tuition Fees – Special Education) and may include a contracted relationship/agreement with a third party.
