


Athletics










Arts Mag





The Grade 8/9 Leadership Program develops emerging leaders by focusing on self-awareness, agency, and teamwork. Each term, 24 students (two from each grade in every House) take part in a 6-session rotation of weekly 45–60 minute sessions. The program is led by Head Students with coaching support from Ms. Weiss. Students learn to recognize their strengths, step outside their comfort zones, and practice taking initiative within a team. This is the first stage in Collingwood's leadership pathway, preparing students to transition from personal leadership in Grades 8–9 to leading for others in Grades 10–12.




Public Speaking


